#### FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT 2017

Lent can be a poignant time for reflection, for looking at our lives and our relationships with the world and asking 'how am I doing?' Lent invites us to enter into a subtle transformation with the people and the world around us.

This year we journey with the people of Honduras, a country that is suffering the devastating consequences of climate injustice. Local communities in Honduras are being forced from their homes into the wilderness because of climate change. The Atlantic Ocean, which was previously one hundred metres from some of their homes, is now merely metres from their doors. Each time there is bad weather they must evacuate. People are afraid of the sea and the swelling rivers which bring floods. It is an injustice that those who have done the least to cause this situation are the ones who suffer the most.

In Pope Francis letter Laudato Si' he says:

I wish to address every person living on this planet . . . I would like to enter into dialogue with all people about our common home . . . As never before in history, common destiny beckons us to seek a new beginning. Let ours be a time remembered for the awakening of a new reverence for life, the firm resolve to achieve sustainability, the quickening of the struggle for justice and peace, and the joyful celebration of life.
