We regret that we were unable to hold an AGM this year but will be doing so early in the New Year. We would hope that family and neighbours will be keeping an eye on relatives and friends during the Winter months, making sure they have food and fuel, and taking their medications. Be sure to remind elderly people to keep doors and windows locked and have their care unit pendants on their person at all times. The Chairman and Committee wish all parishioners a Very Happy Christmas and safe and healthy New Year.

We would also like to remind people to be responsible about their dogs at this time of year as it is a peak lambing time from now until the Spring. Every year we ask people to keep dogs locked up at night, and to have them on leads when out walking. In spite of sending out reminders the killing of sheep and lambs by stray dogs goes on and is a huge loss to farmers. All dogs found roaming on farms will be shot on sight as is allowed by law. If you have dogs you must be responsible for them.

We made an effort during the early Summer months to supply cyclists and walkers/joggers with free high-viz jackets to keep them safe on our narrow roads around the parish. It is most disappointing to see so many people out walking with no high visibility outdoor wear. It is not possible for motorists to see walkers and joggers on road on dull days and almost impossible during night time hours.
