Our club lost another link in the chain of people who helped and worked for our club since its foundation in 1966, with the death of Eileen Hayes at the weekend. Eileen was laid to rest in Tynaclash cemetery after her funeral mass in Talbotstown on Sunday, like her late husband Birdie.

Eileen helped out our club in many ways during the years in the early seventies when catering events & presentations would be held in Talk of The Towm. Eileen would cook dozens of chickens in her own home, and would make the best potato salad known to man or woman. She would help out when we ran marquee dancing, by looking after the cloakroom, & making tea for all the bands that played. Eileen helped in many ways by selling tickets for every draw which was run by the club, supporting Lord Mayor committees, supporting club cabarets, dances, dinner dances. Eileen was always available to help and never said no. Her door was always open.

Eileen was involved in other committees in the village, Kiltegan Tidy Towns, Kiltegan Development Association, & Kiltegan Christmas tree lights.

To her family, sons Denis & Billy, daughters Marian, Loretta, Doris, Eileen, Valerie and Sandra, sisters Ann & Margie, relatives & friends our deepest sympathies. May she rest in peace.
