RATHVILLY COMMUNITY ALERT / TEXT ALERT

Following the Community Engagement Forum organised by the Gardai, the following are some recommendations to follow to aid in the prevention of crime and the theft of your property:-

1. **ENSURE** garden sheds and outbuildings are secured. For as little as €60 you can extend your house alarm to cover the shed.
2. **MARK** your property with your EirCode using a UV pen. In the event of it being stolen, and then recovered by Gardai, it can be traced back to the rightful owner.
3. **INSTALL** a GPS tracker on valuable items like trailers and caravans. These can be bought for as little as €150 and can be linked directly to your mobile phone.
4. **DO NOT** put your life on Facebook, especially when you go on holiday. At least wait until you return home to post a notice.
5. **DO NOT** give out any of your personal details over the 'phone or via email.
6. **DO NOT** keep cash in your home.
7. If anything is stolen check on Donedeal (www.Donedeal.ie) to see if it is being offered for sale.
