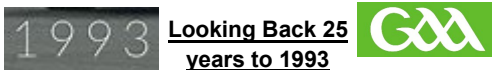

On Saturday the 28th Aug '93 our club received bad news that our patron, former president & great friend of our club, Parish Preist of the dioses of Rathvilly/Kiltegan Fr. Bernard Ryan had died suddenly.

Sunday the 29th County Senior Hurling Championship final– Kiltegan Vs Glenealy in Aughrim @ 3:30pm. Our team wore black arm bands as a mark of respect to the late Fr. Ryan. A minutes silence was held before the throw-in. We won the game 3-7 to 1-4. We were behind at half time– Kiltegan 1-3 to Glenealy 1-4, in fact we were so good in the 2nd half the opposition did not score. Our scores on the day came from – Ned Cremin 2-1, Raymond Byrne 1-6, John Keogh 3 points, Noel Goggin 2 points & Flash Byrne 1 point. We were champions for the 2nd time in the history of the club.

Our Intermediate Hurling Team also got to the County Intermediate Hurling Final when they beat Aughrim in the semi-final in Aughrim on Friday 27th of August on a score line of 2-10 to 0-10.

Our Junior Hurlers played the 1st round of their Championship also on 29th Aug against Barndarrig and won 1-9 to 1-2. Keith Furlong scoring 1-8 & Joe Cleary 0-1.

Monday 30th Fr. Bernard Ryan was buried in Rathvilly, our club formed a Guard of Honor. Later that evening there was a celebration dinner in The Talk of the Town for the winning team.
