Chicken Soup Recipe



Ingredients:

- 55g/2oz butter
- 2 onions, sliced
- 2 sticks celery, finely chopped
- 2 carrots, finely diced
- 25g/2oz plain flour
- 1.2 litres/2 pints chicken stock
- 450g/1lb cooked skinless chicken
- 1 tbsp chopped fresh parsley
- Salt & freshly ground black pepper



Method:

-Melt the butter in a large saucepan over a medium heat & gently fry the onions, celery & carrots until they start to soften.

-Stir in flour & cook for 2 mins. Add the chicken stock & bring the mixture to the boil, stirring as you do. Season with salt & pepper, then reduce the heat until mixture is simmering and simmer for 10 mins, until the veg is tender.

-Add cooked chicken and cook until heated through. Adjust the seasoning, stir in the parsley and serve.

WINTER WARMER

Speedy Sausage Stew Recipe



Ingredients:

- 8 sausages
- 2 tbsp. oil
- 2 red onions, sliced
- 2 cloves garlic, chopped
- 3 sprigs thyme



- 2 x 250g packs ready-to-eat lentils
- 300 ml (½ pint) chicken stock
- 3 tbsp. balsamic vinegar
- 150 g (5oz) kale

Method:

-In a large frying pan over a high heat, brown the sausages in half the oil for 3min. Remove to a plate.

-Add the remaining oil to the pan with the onions and fry, covered, over a low heat for 10min until softened and lightly browned. Add garlic and thyme, stirring for 1min.

-Return sausages to pan, add lentils, stock and vinegar. Cover and simmer for 10min. Stir in the kale to wilt for 1min and serve.
