Thursday 15th February Michael Dwyers AGM in Rathcoyle school was cancelled due to snow

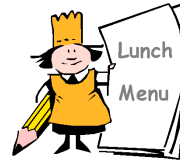
Friday 18th February the first training session was held under Paul Kelly.
