It was agreed at our Committee Meeting that we would need to replenish funds for Texting on our Text Alert system. We have not requested any money for at least two years. A Text Alert has been sent out regarding the new method of payment - which will be  $\in 10$ . It will no longer be possible to drop an envelope into the Credit Union letterbox, but to make payment directly at the desk, and fill in a lodgement slip, which should give your name and mobile number. The Text Alert Account Number is 47992 - Account Name is Community Text Alert Rathvilly. You can also give the money to a committee member at anytime. We hope this will not be an inconvenience, and if you have any difficulty about payment please do not hesitate to telephone the Text Alert 'phone 085 100 8269 or any Committee member. You will need to have paid your subscription by the 1st August to continue receiving Text Alerts.

Text Alert covers Text Alert groups countrywide. Gardai tell us that it has been a most useful facilitator in crime prevention over the last few years.
