Open Meetings and Core Group

Two open meetings of interested parishioners have now taken place, one in the Phoenix Centre and one in St Tegan's Hall, Kiltegan. A third meeting (open to all) is planned for 8 pm on **Tuesday 30th July** in the Phoenix Centre, Rathvilly. There have been very useful sharings of ideas for the invigoration of our parish and of the faith of our people. We have identified many challenges and sought to understand and confront them. Like other parishes we are aware of the huge changes in our society and of the effects of a more secular atmosphere in our country.

The meetings were valuable because they provided opportunities for sharing and listening. We know that together we can do much. With the aging profile of the clergy of the whole diocese (and few younger priests), lay people are becoming more conscious of the need to become more involved in taking responsibility for the life and faith of the parishes. We have identified some actions which we propose as we move forward. In accordance with diocesan policy, we have given some thought to the formation of a 'Parish Core Group' of parishioners who would take a focused interest in assisting the progress of the parish. We feel that this is an immediate priority for our parish and we would like to start such a Group in September 2019. It is envisaged that such a group would involve four of five lay persons who would be trained and briefed on the workings of the parish and who would work closely with the diocese on all parish related matters.

I invite expressions of interest from persons interested in joining the core group or recommendations of persons you might consider suitable. If you feel you may be interested or can identify someone who might be invited to join, please send in your name or the names of suitable people to the parish office.
