ASH WEDNESDAY - Day of Fast and Abstinence

Regulations for Fasting in Lent. As Catholics we are asked to abstain from meat and to fast on two days in the year, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means that one full meatless meal can be eaten in the day. Two other meatless meals may be taken to maintain strength but together they should not exceed one full meal. Liquids, including milk and fruit juice, may be taken between meals. The fasting regulation applies to all Catholics aged 18 to 59 while those aged fourteen and above are asked to abstain from meat. Some people are not required to fast; these include those who are sick, pregnant or nursing women and manual labourers according to need. In the past, Irish Catholics were required to abstain from meat every Friday.

Trócaire's Lenten campaign for 2020 highlights the different ways in which mothers are protecting their families, from the effects of climate change and from the actions of corporations. Lent 2020 asks people in Ireland to show their love by supporting people in the world's poorest countries. This year, we hear the stories of two families, living in Honduras and Kenya.
