Parishioners who pay income tax can use their tax to help the parish financially.

The scheme helps to recognise the support that people give to the parish. Each parishioner's donation is treated with the utmost confidence. The CHY3 forms have been sent out to parishioners who has contributed €250 or more to the parish.

CHY3 Form is valid for a period of five years. The parish can claim a refund from the Revenue Commissioners on these contributions. The parish will not receive any information on any individual's circumstances. If you wish the parish to claim the refund, sign the form and return it to the parish office. If you are no longer liable for tax, let us know so that we can update our records.
