



# Kilfegan Tidy Towns

Kiltegan Tidy Towns have played a major part of life in our area for many years. The Tidy Towns committee was formed in 1966. It's first chairperson was Fr. Charlie Smith from St. Patricks College, Kiltegan—a Cavan man, Vice Chairperson was Hugh Raffterty, Treasurers: Peter Kenny & Dick Harmon. Secretary was Mrs Nuala Darcy (PO). They had budget of £404.08 raised through dance, raffle & voluntary contributions. They were awarded 94 marks out of a possible 150 marks that year—they made steady progress over the next years: 1967 (99 marks), 1968 (103 marks), 1969 (108 marks), 1970 (122 marks), 1971 (132 marks), 1971 (132 marks) where Kiltegan received the Board Failte Prize for the best village effort. 1972 (138 marks) when Kiltegan took 1st Place in the Eastern Region and then in 1973, the overall National Award with 140 points and the title of Ireland's Tidiest Town winning a Commerative Plague and £1,000 as well as Wells. Fleetwood & Nilfisk Awards.

This was an entire community effort—there were so many incredible volunteers who are not mentioned above—they all brought great enthusiasm and did so much great work for our Kiltegan village & community.
