TEMPORARY CARE ASSISTANT

(18 hours/week)

A temporary vacancy has arisen for a Care Assistant at the Care Unit in St. Patrick's Missionary Society. This position will be based across the Unit and may include one to one care for a resident.

The role of the care assistant is to deliver a high standard of care to residents and to perform associated duties. The care assistant works with a registered nurse or fellow care assistant as appropriate. The main duties and responsibilities of the position are in the areas of Hygiene, Nutrition, Mobilisation and Communication and the working relationship should be built on respect, open communication and trust. The care assistant must at all times treat residents with respect and dignity while providing their care.

This position will be for two 9-hour shifts per week of 6am to 3pm and 3pm to midnight which may be rostered over any of the seven days.

Previous experience as a Care Assistant and QQI (Fetac) Level 5 qualification are both requirements of this position.
