Gospel: Luke 9:51-62 The Way

primarily concerned with Jesus' journey to Jerusalem (Lk 9:51-27). The time for Jesus to 'set his face towards Jerusalem' has arrived. The narrative takes on a solemn tone, depicting Jesus' determination but also anticipating the challenges that lie ahead. It will not be a straight path for the Jesus community. There will be hospitality along the road, but it will also involve rejection and struggle.

This way to Jerusalem is symbolic of the Christian journey, and indeed the early Christians movement was known as "The Way". This is a term sometimes used today to refer to the famous pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela in the north of Spain. Anyone who has walked the Camino knows what a deeply spiritual experience it can be. Yes, there are blisters, aches and pains, stifling heat and not-so-comfortable sleeping conditions, but it is also a road of discovery, friendship, prayer, hospitality and solidarity. There is something very transformative about walking day after day. The body becomes attuned to the earth. You engage on a different level with nature, villages, communities, changing landscapes, new faces – and ultimately with Christ who dwells within. Few people are the same after this experience. For the disciples, this will certainly be true of their journey.

At the end of the text, Jesus' words to the one who wishes to join them may seem harsh. Why shouldn't this person be allowed to wrap up loose ends before embarking on the Way? Jesus' call is one that radically uproots people; it is a difficult walk that should deeply challenge us if we are really living the message of the Gospel.
