Our Senior Hurlers lost out to Glenealy by 2pts. in the County Senior Hurling Championship and Senior Hurling league final in Aughrim on Friday evening on a score line of Kiltegan 1-11 Glenealy 2-10. We did not get into the pace of the game like last week, we were behind at half time 1-6 to 0-5 after hitting 8 wides in the first half. We came more into the game in the second half. We scored an early point before Brandon Ryan levelled the match with about 12 minutes gone, but Glenealy hit back with a goal of their own to go in front once again, a lead they held till Podge O'Toole reduced the lead to two. We had a last minute chance to win the game from a free but Glenealy stood up to the challenge and blocked the shot and referee John Keenan blew the fulltime whistle, game over. We now play Bray-Emmetts in the semi final. Looking back we had 8 wides in the first half and 7 in the second half, 3 of our forwards scored a point each Podge O'Toole, Aaron Byrne & Eoghan Byrne from play, 3 of our forwards failed to score from play, Seanie Germaine scored 7 points from frees, Brandon Ryan 1-1 from the half back line. We conceded 2 soft goals and we still only lost by 2 points and we only used 1 sub.
