LOOKING BACK TO 1997

After loosing our Co. Senior Hurling crown to Glenealy at the Semi final stage of the Co. Senior Hurling championship in 1996 when we were going for four in a row and we were leading at half time 0-11 to 0-2, we lost this match by a two point margin 2-13 to 0-16. A lot of players were still hurting by this defeat and looked forward to the championship of 1997.

Under trainer Molin Morrissery, selectors Sean Keogh, Brian Graham we started our campaign with wins over Kilcool, Arklow Rocks Parnell's, and Co. Champions Glenealy in our group. We played Arklow Rocks Parnell's in the semi final and won 2-15 to 0-4. We played our old rival St. Patricks, Wicklow Town in the Co. Final on September 21st in Aughrim and won 1-12 to 1-06. Super sub Michael Cullen scored a goal and a point when introduced in the second half to ensure victory. John Keogh our captain received the Donal Ó Donohue cup on behalf of the team for the 5th time since our first in 1987.

We played Rathmoylan, Meath in the first round of the Leinster Championship and beat them 1-10 to 0-8. We faced the mighty All Ireland and Leinster champions Birr from Offaly in the second round and they gave us a lesson in hurling beaten us 3-15 to 1-06, but the experience of playing a team at this level would stand to us down the line.

We scored a total of 11 goals 73 points in the Wicklow Championship and conceded 4 goals 28 points. We played 4 games in the Co. Hurling league won all four and the league was not finished.
