John 1:6-8; 19-28 Testify to the light Last Sunday we were introduced to John the Baptist as part of our Advent journey. We hear his story again today, this time from the Fourth Gospel, the Gospel of John. Because Mark gives us very little detail about John the Baptist we turn to John the evangelist to hear the Baptist's testimony. Light and darkness is a key theme of the Fourth Gospel and in its opening verses it proclaims that this light has always shone in the dark; the darkness cannot overpower it. The evangelist goes on to tell us of John the Baptist's mission: he has been sent by God to 'speak for the light'. John is the light bearer; he is not the light. He is a witness to the light of God in the world, a light that cannot be put out. The priests and the Levites want to know who John the Baptist is and what he is doing baptising people in the Jordan. John is calling people to a change of heart, to a new way of living.

There is much darkness in our world, many wildernesses to navigate in our society, in our communities and in our relationships with one another. From time to time, someone comes on the scene to shine a light into that darkness. A mediator steps into a family feud, a young climate activist ignite a global movement, millions of young people become politically engaged, a mentor gives the right advice at just the right time, a friend makes a phone call that brightens up someone's day, a community opens their hearts to refugees. We all experience wilderness in our lives at various times. When in these desert spaces remember that God's grace can come at any moment. Somewhere in the dark, a light shines that the darkness cannot overcome. We celebrate this light today on Gaudete Sunday – *Gaudete* means 'rejoice'. We light the pink candle and we celebrate with joy.
