#### Looking back over 50 years

When our GAA club was founded in 1966 juvenile football and hurling was not on the agenda. In 1971 the first attempt at juvenile games was a joint effort between the GAA and the Foroige Club to run a football tournament as part of a weekend gala event which was run by the Foroige club led by a student from St. Patrick's Collage by the name of Mossey Crowley. The three local schools entered teams Rathcoyle, Tynock and Talbotstown which was played on a round robin basis with each team playing one another over the week end with the final played on Easter Sunday after 11 am mass.

As the now GAA field was only new to the area those games were played in the now car park as this was the only space at the time. The goal posts were timber posts from the forestry in Humewood and a rope was tied between them for the cross bar. Rathcoyle team was managed by the late Hugh Byrne who was the teacher in Rathcoyle along with the help of his son Sean and son in law Conn O'Sullivan. While John Timmins managed both the Tynock and Talbotstown teams and also transported both teams to the venue.

Rathcoyle and Tynock reached the final with Rathcoyle winning the medals by a single point. Mr. Joe O'Toole formerly from Rathdangan and Baltinglass refereed the final. Some of the people that played on the teams over that weekend were Tynock: Jack & Tom Byrne, Knocklishen, Tom Byrne, Tynock Hill, Martin & Ned Bowes, and Denis Cremin. On the Rathcoyle team was; John Duffy, Hugh Harmon, Hugh Cullen, Donal O'Keefe and Joe Shortall, on the Talbotstown team was: John & James Mc Grath, John & Thomas Murphy, Ned Crimin, Tom Crimin, Martin Dowling and Tom Carty. If anyone can come up with more names that played on those teams let John Timmins know. Minor, under 16, under 14 players from the area played with neighbours Baltinglass in the championship.

So ended juvenile matters in the Kiltegan Rathdangan area for another year.
