SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

In his encyclical Laudato Si', Pope Francis urges everyone on the planet to embrace or reawaken a new sense of awe and wonder for creation. We are invited to see the interconnectedness of all things and reflect on how interdependent we all are with nature. He refers to this as 'an integral ecology'. We are urged to see and reflect on the glory of God present in all of creation. Ask yourself this question today: 'Have I lost my sense of awe and wonder amidst so much noise in my life?'

The Gospel of Creation is calling to us now, into these 'wow' moments, into the same wonder and awe that the disciples must have felt in the gospel. The disciples want to stay with Jesus on the mountain, and who can blame them? But they must leave: 'Stand up, do not be afraid ...' (Mt 17:7). Jesus' path is not one on which we can remain in our comfort zones. It is a challenging way and there is a cost involved.
