SAINT OLIVER PLUNKETT

Sunday, 1st July - St Oliver Plunkett from Irish nobility whose family supported King Charles 1. Ordained in Rome in 1654 he became a Professor of Theology from 1654 through 1669. He was appointed Archbishop of Armagh in 1669. He was forced to conduct a covert ministry during the suppression of priests. He was arrested and tried at Dundalk in 1679 for conspiring against the State. It was seen that Oliver would never be convicted in Ireland, and he was moved to Newgate prison, London. St Oliver Plunkett was found guilty of high treason 'for promoting the Catholic faith', and was condemned to a gruesome death. He was martyred 1 July 1681 at Tyburn, by hanging, disembowelling, quartering and beheading. He was the last Catholic to die for his faith at Tyburn, and the first of the Irish martyrs to be beatified. His body was initially buried in two tin boxes next to five Jesuits who had died before; his head is in St Peter's Church at Drogheda, Ireland; most of his body is at Downside Abbey, England; and some relics are in Ireland.
