Our Senior Hurlers had their first taste of Senior Hurling Championship action when they took on last years beaten County Finalist Bray Emmetts at Aughrim on Monday evening & lost on a score line of 3-17 to 2-11. Bray Emmetts scored a point straight away from the throw-in & were always in control of the game & were leading at half-time 1-11 to 0-4.
