1993 Looking Back 25 years ago to 1993 

Kiltegan Senior Hurling team played Avondale in Aughrim on Sunday the 15th of August 1993 in the semi-final of the Championship which ended in a draw Kiltegan 2-8 Avondale 1-11. We were losing at half time by 5 points 1-3 to 1-8 they scored 5 of their points from free's, we only scored 1 point from a free. Scores on the day came from John Keogh 1-2, Andy Coleman 1-1, Ned Cremin 2 points & Tom Cremin, Noel Goggin + Sean Byrne 1 point each.

The replay was fixed for Aughrim on Friday the 20th of August '93 @ 7.30pm, which we won 1-10 to Avondales 0-4. We were now in the County Senior Hurling final against Glenealy on the 29th of August '93. Our scores against Avondale were Michael Cullen 1-0, John Keogh 4points, Nigel Byrne & Sean Byrne 2 points each + Raymond Byrne & Noel Goggin 1 point each.

Our Intermediate Hurling team were also busy preparing for their Championship. They played a challenging match against Graiguecullen in Graiguecullen on Sunday the 22nd August '93 & lost 0-6 to 1-4. Half-time Kiltegan 0-2 to 0-1, a very low scoring game.
