You will receive a phone call from a lady or man with foreign accents sounding very credible and polite to convince you that they are calling from your bank. This is not the case. Do not be fooled by any requests from any individual seeking your personal details. Simply cut them off. Also, similar telephone calls are being made to householders regarding computers. They trick you into believing there is a problem with your equipment and ask you to open your computer while they talk you through instructions to 'repair the fault'. This is a scam also, and by giving them any information at all they can have access to your bank accounts, personal details, etc. It is up to you to take care of these details.
