SAINTS THIS WEEK

Monday – St Martin de Porres, 1579-1639, became a Dominican lay brother, spending his nights in prayer and penance, and his days in the monastery, caring for the sick and the poor. He is renowned for his devotion to the Blessed Sacrament.

Wednesday – **St Willibrord** was born in Northumbria in 658. He entered the Benedictine order and was sent to study. After ordination he was sent with eleven companions to evangelise Frisia. He established a mission at Utrecht and in 695 was ordained Archbishop of Utrecht by Pope Sergius I. He founded a monastery at Echternach in Luxembourg in 700, where he died in 739.

Thursday – St Albert the Great, c. 1206-80, the Dominican theologian, who taught in Cologne, was called the 'Universal Doctor' for the vast range of his interests. Patron of scientists.

Friday – St Margaret, 1045-93, wife of Malcolm III, King of Scotland, helped by her example and influence the work of reform in the Church.

St Gertrude, 1256-1302, a Benedictine nun, from the age of five she cultivated devotion to the Sacred Heart and advocated frequent Communion.

Saturday – St Elizabeth of Hungary, 1207-31, queen at fourteen, widowed and exiled at twenty, Franciscan tertiary until her death at twenty-four. A woman of prayer and service of the poor.
