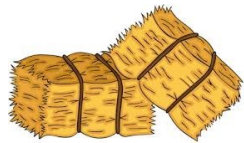

### Care Unit Relief Laundry & Cleaning Assistant

This role arises from a need to  
provide relief cover in the Care Unit  
for holidays, sick leave and parental  
leave  
(one shift per week for eight weeks).

When working in the Laundry, the Assistant must  
ensure current laundry guidelines/practices are  
followed and that there is an adequate supply of  
clean laundry to cater for the needs of the Care Unit.  
He/she has responsibility for the tagging/identification  
of personal laundry and reports any repairs that are  
required to personal laundry e.g. missing buttons.  
The Laundry Assistant carries out laundry (washing  
& ironing) duties as per the weekly schedule e.g.  
personal laundry, sheets, towels, face cloths, cloths  
etc.

When cleaning, the Assistant has responsibility for  
the cleanliness, tidiness and hygiene of areas  
specified by his/her manager and must adhere to  
safe work practices and health & safety guidelines  
e.g. wet floor signs, correct food storage, lifting, PPE  
including gloves, correct shoes etc.. He/she must  
familiarise him/herself with any chemicals used on a  
daily basis including correct use, storage and disposal.  
He/she carries out cleaning duties as per the weekly  
schedule.

The Laundry & Cleaning Assistant must have due  
respect for the property of individual residents and  
Society property at all times.
