Our Club and Community said their final goodbyes to our sporting legend and friend Peter "Coney" Byrne on Saturday afternoon as his remains were interred in Cranerin Cemetery following a moving service in Kilamoate Church. Hundreds of people from far and near paid their respects to Peter at his home in Ballymaconey and at his funeral on Saturday. Club Members, playing colleagues, camogie club members and players, juvenile players and many friends turned out as a Guard Of Honor was formed as Peter's remains passed the GAA field on his way home to his house on Thursday evening. The cortege stopped outside the GAA field where a minutes silence and a silent prayer was said. Coney had many sporting memories here as a player, trainer and selector. Our club members and communities rallied together in many ways parking cars, stewarding, baking on Friday and Saturday. Guards of Honor was formed by the adult & juvenile club as well as the camogie club and Michael Dwyers at the church and graveyard and the large numbers that came out was a testament of the high respect everyone held for Peter. Hundreds of mourners turned out to pay their respects to their loved legend "Coney" - it was one of the largest funerals in the area which showed how much Peter was loved. Peter's remains were laid to rest in his family plot where music from his many musical memories was played after final prayers. Coney— May the Soil of Cranerin lay lightly on your Soul. R.I.P Peter.
