



His sisters, daughters in Law, Grandchildren, relatives & friends. All his sons played and are active members of our club. Colm is our present Secretary. The late Ger played with his native Rathdangan when they had teams in 1949, the fifties and 1960-61. In 1961 Rathdangan won the West Final when they beat Dunlavin 2-8 to 0-2. Ger played full back on the team. They played Forestry College in the County Junior Football semi-final in Aughrim and lost 4-5 to 1-11. This was the last team that Rathdangan filled. Ger had played at full forward in the first round of the Junior Championship against Donard and scored 1-2. Ger was Chairman of the Rathdangan Club on two ocassions, 1956 and 1961. His love for the game continued and he was a great supporter of our club in Kiltegan from the time his own lads starting playing juvenile football & hurling, he was very proud of his lads achievements on and off the field. He was a great supporter of our weekly lotto, never missing a week and was also a Jackpot winner of €5.000 in 2009. He enjoyed following the various teams in our club over the years and the last couple of years when he was unable to attend, he kept in touch by mobile phone to Colm or Killian asking how did it go. Our club formed a guard of honour at his funeral on Sunday. Ger was laid to rest in his native Cranareen Cemetery. Rest in Peace Ger and may the soil of your native Rathdangan lay lightly on your soul.
