Remembering Peter 'Coney' Byrne

A weekend of remembrance for Peter 'Coney' Byrne will take place in Rathdangan on the 7th & 8th of September.

Peter was tragically killed in a farm accident in April this year and his loss is still deeply felt by the communities of Rathdangan and Kiltegan. Rathdangan Community Council is organising two events to remember Peter.

The Lap of Coney run/walk/crawl will take place on Saturday 7th at 5pm. Registration closes at 4.30 and the event starts at 5pm sharp. The route will circle the townland of Ballymaconey where Peter lived. There will be 5km. 8km and 10km options.

On Sunday the 8th of September a tractor run will take place in Rathdangan starting at 2pm. Registration will be open from 11am to 1.30pm. The route will be a longer loop around Ballymaconey. All drivers must be licensed and insured. This will be followed by an auction and live music outside Junior's Bar that evening.
