RATHVILLY COMMUNITY ALERT/TEXT ALERT

We are pleased to report that our Chairman William Burgess was the recipient of a Garda Award at a Community Awards Night in Kilkenny this week. William was nominated by our Committee, having served on Rathvilly Community Alert for almost 30 years, and latterly as Chairman. He is a very hands-on person, always ready to help anyone when asked, especially the elderly in the parish during the Winter months. He also saw the great potential of setting up Text Alert in our area and he erected the signage around the parish to indicate that we are Text Alert users in the area.

With regard to the forthcoming Winter we are encouraging people with elderly relatives to help them to be prepared for bad weather, and that their homes are well heated. They should also ensure that people on medications are using them and have adequate supplies of them. People with care units should also ensure that they are wearing their pendants and that everyone who is a subscriber to Text Alert keeps their mobile phones charged up.

Text Alert subscribers WHO HAVE NOT YET PAID should now do so as quickly as possible, by calling into the Credit Union during their opening hours, to be certain that they receive alerts. If anyone has any problems about doing this please contact a member of our committee who will be more than happy to assist them.
