Death is the end of earthy life, but 'not of our existence' since the soul is immortal. Seen from the perspective of the faith, 'death is the end of man's earthly pilgrimage, of the time of grace and mercy which God offers him so as to work out his earthly life in keeping with the divine plan, and to decide his ultimate destiny'. 2021 Pope Francis extended to the end of November the period of Indulgences for the Holy Souls.
