It is with regret and sadness that we learn of the death of Ann (Nan) Kenny, Hillview, Kiltegan on Tuesday night. Ann was one of the unsung heroes of our club. Going back to 1970 when we bought our first set of jerseys, Ann volunteered to wash & look after them. She had no mod-cons, the water was carried from a well down in the wood where she lived in Humewood, she

used a steel bath & washboard and received the sum of £1 per month. Her late husband Jack became chairperson in 1971. When our club held their first dinner dance in the Slaney Hotel, Tullow Jack & Ann were to the fore selling tickets at £1.50 each. A couple of club meetings were held in their house as we were saving £2, this was the charge to hire St. Tegan's Hall. When we rented the Parish Field in 1970 there was always fundraising raffles etc. We ran marquees and Ann would cater for the teas. She ran the shop during the festival that we ran & the seven-a-side football matches. She sold tickets for various gimmicks she thought up at our annual field day. When we purchased the playing field in 1982 she bought a doll and put it behind Joan Culberts counter & sold tickets for "Guess the Name of the Doll" which raised £80. When we started to build the present dressing rooms in 1984 she travelled the County selling lines for John Timmins Lord Mayor Campaign at 50p a line. In 1983 we decided the club needed a weekly income so a deal was struck with the owner of The Talk of the Town, Declan Doyle, that we would run a weekly Cabaret show every Friday night & we also ran a jackpot. Ann collected 50p entry every Friday night for about a year or more, John Timmins sold the tickets inside. Some nights we only made £25 other nights we made £70-£80. When our lotto started Ann was one of our promoters for many years. When our club got to the County Finals over the years, Ann was out on her own making flags & headbands— she was a dab hand at the sewing machine, she was the only one making these flags & she was always available to take in a trousers or dress for the locals as well. In the early years Ann loved to socialise. Herself & John Timmins teamed up once at a talent contest singing "The Hole in the Bucket". Apart from the GAA, Ann was a member of the Tidy Towns in the village. She worked for many years, doing many jobs like taking the moss off the bridge & planting & looking after the flowerbed where you turn up to Tynock, which was known as Nan's Corner. Ann's husband Jack passed away 38 years ago which left her to bring up a young family of 6 which she can be proud of. When once asked what do you think of the recession her answer was— what recession? Ann was also a regular reader of The Focus every week which was left in her letterbox. This is just a short few words about Ann, a lady & a true Gael for the GAA club & our community. *May she Rest in Peace.* To her son John, her daughters Catherine, Mary, Jackie, Denise & Carline, sister Margaret, brother Sean, all her relatives and friends, our sympathy.
