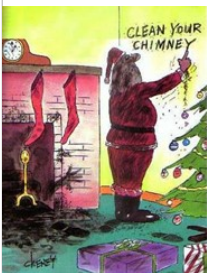

Leylandii Hedge (50 metres)

Kiltegan Tidy Towns volunteers in conjunction with residents will be removing the Leylandii hedging at the top of the **Green on Saturday 6th November 21 @9am.**

The roots of the leylandii hedging will be later removed and the ground prepared for planting.

Kiltegan Tidy Towns have been successful in securing funding through Wicklow County Council to replace the Leylandii hedging with native beech hedging and post and rail fencing which will be installed in due course.



At the back of the Leylandii hedging is a historic shoeing stone which will be cleaned and restored as part of this project. This is part of our Kiltegan Heritage. If anyone has any time to lend a hand towards any of these works it would greatly benefit the Kiltegan Community.
