A collection of essential items to support Ukrainian people will be held at Kiltegan Club Grounds between Tuesday March 8th and Wednesday March 16th .Lorries/vans leaving our areas weekly to go to border countries and items are needed.

Essential items are:

Food Products - dry foods such as pasta/rice, tinned food, tinned fish, tinned vegetables, baby food, biscuits, sweets, sugar, tea and coffee, water.

Hygiene Products - wet wipes, roll on deodorant, soap/shower gel, toothpaste, toothbrushes, toilet paper, shampoo, sanitary products, towels.

Sleeping - blankets, sheets, pillows, sleeping bags, camping mats.

Medical supplies - bandages, tape, antiseptics, first aid kits.

Children Items - Nappies/Baby Creams, colouring books, crayons)

Lighting & Power - Flashlights, batteries, power bank, candles,

Everything that comes in needs to be packaged in a cardboard box and sealed for transport, so it would be very helpful if you could bring your items in a sturdy open cardboard box that can be sealed up. If you have any spare cardboard boxes that can be sealed please drop them off also. Bring your item(s) in an open part-filled or filled cardboard box with a closable lid that can be sealed. Drop off to clubhouse dressing room between 9am to 9pm.
