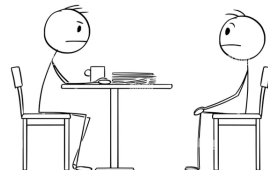
**Building Up Your Curriculum Vitae**

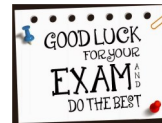
