Tony is celebrating 30 years since his liver transplant and will be forever grateful to his Donor and his family. He was the first person to undergo a liver transplant in Ireland. Tony works as a carpenter and is one of the most experienced members of Transplant Team Ireland having first represented Ireland at the 1995 World Transplant Games in Manchester, England. He has picked up an enormous number of medals across the year and is a highly respected competitor by his peers from across the globe.
