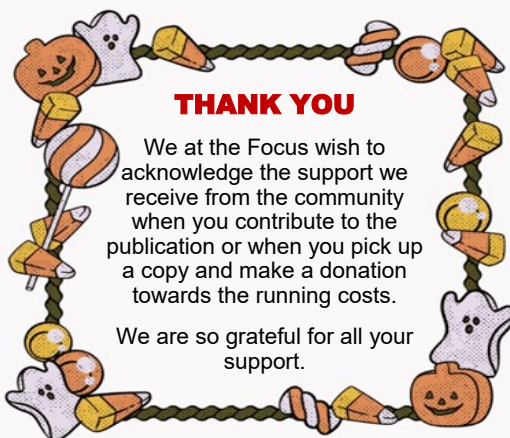

Kiltegan Junior & Senior Camogie County B Champions



Our Junior & Senior Camogie teams brought the curtain down on a very successful year for the club when they won both the Junior and Senior B Camogie Championship finals on Sunday. Beating Ballinacor in the Junior and Bray in the Senior.

Our Junior Camogie team had an early start 11am against Ballinacor and had a two point victory. Kiltegan 1-10 Ballinacor 1-08. Some of our best players found it hard to get to the pace of the game in the first half and we were behind at half time 1-01 to 0-06. After the team talk at half time we started to come more into the game, Ashling O'Toole again to the fore as she has been all year in this championship. She scored some great points from play, frees and 35's, scoring 8 points altogether. Leah Furlong scored 1-01 and Amber House scored a point. Ballinacor scored a goal early in the second half to go 4pts up, but our ladies stood tall and clawed their way back into the game with points from frees by Ashling. We were level going into the last five minutes of the game. We finished the stronger with a free and a 35 both taken by Ashling to win the game. A great performance by the 16 players on the day.

Our captain Catherine Donovan accepted the cup on behalf of her team mates from County Vice Chairperson Morris Molloy. All players put in a great effort this year and all are looking forward to next year. A huge thank you to Elisha Ryan and Tanya Wynn for all their work with this team.

Our Senior Camogie team had a narrow one point win over Bray, final score Kiltegan 1-06 Bray 0-08. Having beaten Bray at home in the league part of the championship a few weeks previously it was always going to be a titanic battle and it was, with both sets of backs on top of their game. Scores were hard to come by. Both sets of midfield players tried hard to get a supply of ball into their forwards. A Sophie Birmingham goal and point, had us holding a slender lead at half time 1-01 to 0-02. The second half was another tight affair with both sets of forwards trying hard to get scores. We were guilty of some bad wides as were our opponents. We were level on a few occasions. The management introduced Roseanna Keogh early in the game to try and strengthen the forward line and introduced star junior player Ashling O'Toole from the first game late in the second half to try and get us a win with both sides level. 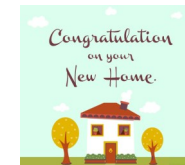
Kiltegan Christmas Tractor Run Saturday 2nd December
