A vacancy exists for the post of CE Supervisor in West Wicklow Community Employment CLG, The Green, Kiltegan, Co. Wicklow. This is a job share post for 19.5 hours per week. You will be based between the Kiltegan & Baltinglass offices of WWCE. The areas covered by the project are Knockananna, Rathdangan, High Park, Kiltegan & Baltinglass.

The post and project are funded by the Department of Employment Affairs & Social Protection.

#### Duties:

- Working effectively and communicating with your counter-part supervisor.
- Regular check-ins at locations where the community employment participants are based daily/weekly as required.
- Prepare work schedules for participants in conjunction with sub-sponsor groups.
- Ensuring all materials/equipment required for work schedules are in place for participants in conjunction with sub-sponsor groups.

- ⇒ Liaise with Assistant Supervisor, Sponsors, sub-sponsors and DEASP.
- ⇒ Ensure the CE Scheme is compliant with monitoring requirements as per DEASP.
