But this was as good as it got for us as Tinahely started to get on top and scored some great points from play and frees. We were now playing catch up. Tinahely scored a goal on the call of half time to leave the score Tinahely 1-09 Kiltegan 0-04 and a steep hill for us to climb in the second half. The management made some positional changes and introduced Ciaran Harmon for the second half. Kieran Conway was having the game of his life popping up all over the field.
