1976 LOOKING BACK TO 1976:

Kiltegan Under 12 Football team won no Silverware but they competed in the West Championship. They beat Blessington 8-6 to 3-1 but lost their next match to St. Kevin's, they also played in the Teachers Cup.

Board Affiliation & insurance £30, football £12.50, repairing football £5.50, calculator £7, All Ireland tickets £23, filling cups for celebration drinks £54.87, Hurlies & Balls £134.60. laundering of iersevs £29.85. medical expenses £86.05, training of teams £271, mowing field £6, printing reports/copy books £9.64. Running a marguee was the top income at £2,220.39, expenses lighting etc. £1,776.58,

raffles, field day seven-a-side tournament & our

dinner dance were some of the fundraising done

in 1976.
