### Looking back 60 years of GAA in Kiltegan

60 years ago April 30<sup>th</sup> 1966 St Tegan's GAA club fielded a Junior Football Team for the first time since they formed a club on the 9<sup>th</sup> April 1966. They played Dunlavin in Baltinglass in the Corcoran Cup, final score St Tegan's 1-1 Dunlavin 1-6,

Dunlavin took control, they went 4 points up after 20 minutes of play to no score, the leaders had a goal disallowed 3 minutes later and this was the score at half time. St Tegan's continued to fight back but it was only 10 minutes into the second half when their centre half forward Danny Byrne got through for a well taken goal. However, Dunlavin scored a goal 8 minutes to go. St Tegan's were fighting a losing battle.
