Our Senior Football Team welcomed Hollywood to Kiltegan on Friday evening for the play off of the County Senior Football League which we won on a score line of Kiltegan 2-12 Hollywood 1-12. A good exciting game of football played in wet greasy conditions which caused both sides errors during the game. We got off to a flying start when Stephen Farrell pointed within a few minutes, followed soon after with a two pointer by the same player, from a free, Jack O'Toole scored a goal after being set up by Seanie Furlong. Hollywood came back into the game with a couple of scores, Seanie Furlong scored a goal, & points from Kieran Harmon + Stephen Farrell left us leading at half time 2-6 to 0-6. Hollywood got off to a great start to the second half with a two pointer, but Ciaran Harmon got back our lead with a great two pointer. We were leading by 7 points with 38 minutes played, but Hollywood came more and more into the game scoring a goal and a two pointer, they levelled the game with 55 minutes gone and it looked like a draw or would Hollywood score again? Conor Boland steadied the ship with a two-pointer, and our goalie Emmet Murphy, who had an excellent game, saved us on several occasions. We missed a penalty late in the game to close the gap, which their goalie saved, but overall they were that little bit better and ran out the winners in the end. Now the players look forward to the upcoming Junior Championship in August; the draw for this has still to be decided. Our scores came from: Eoin Byrne 1-1, Conor Boland 0-6, Chris O'Toole, and Stephen Coogan 1 point each.
