27th February: West Wicklow GAA Board Meeting, Edward O'Toole, Mick M & Peter Whelan represented Rathdangan. Transfer ruled out at meeting for William Byrne, Michael Ryan &

Patrick O'Leary from Rathdangan to Stratford.

Distrect League eight teams entered home and away junior teams only.

26th March Rathdangan 2-4 to Stratford 1-4.

9th April: Mr Michael Byrne Ballymaconey won a prize in the Gael-Linn Draw.

30th April: Rathdangan Football Clubs drama class fund raiser presented "An Angel without a Halo" in Rathdangan Hall.
